

Panguitch Elementary  
Community Council Minutes  
March 11, 2015

**Council Members Present:** Alberto Vasquez, Ashlee Miller, Annie Anderson, Christy Evans, Jacie Torgersen & Scot Campbell came at 10:20am.

Principal Nick Reynolds was there and Schoolboard member Mike Savage.

The meeting was held at the district office. Alberto Vasquez started the meeting at 10am. Mr. Reynolds presented the council some information on the money that has been spent for the 2014-2015 year. The money has been spent on the music program, salaries for the computer aide and reading lab aides, & technology. The council did have money allotted to spend for reading textbooks but this changed since the school district is adopting a new Language Arts Basal. Some of this money was moved to technology for more purchases there. The projected amount of carryover is \$34,256.00. This number may change depending on the amount spent on salaries. The hours for the computer aide change depending on how much testing is taking place.

The Community Council money is going to be audited and there is a concern about having too much money as a carryover. The council would like to use this money to pay for aides next year so it has been earmarked, but not spent yet. The council asked Mr. Savage how the school board felt about having money as a carryover and he said it was fine from their end. The council asked if it would be possible to put that money in a fund in the district office for salaries for next year? Mr. Reynolds will check with the business administrator to see if that is possible. The legislature may not give the community council the same allotment next year if they feel that the money is not being used. The council has had bigger amounts to carryover in the past, but it has never been audited before. The carryover amount has been going down each year which is good. However, the council will not be able to fund the reading aide labs and computer aide after next year because they will not have the money left to do so.

The council reviewed the 2015-2016 School LAND Trust Plan. Christy Evans motioned to approve the plan and Annie Anderson seconded the motion, the vote was unanimous.

The next meeting will be held on April 15, 2015 at 10am.
