### **1. Welcome**

The council suggested putting more money in the plan for professional development for the teachers.

This could fall under the requirement for digital citizenship training.

### **3. Community Council Training**

Mr. Reynolds had prepared a booklet to do a training for the community council. He went through and explained how the Trust Lands money was established, how it can be used and what the duties and responsibilities of the council are. There is also some online training available.

### **5. Organize Council**

Council members decided to wait and appoint a chairman, vice chairman and secretary at the next meeting when all members are present.
